COVID-19 update from LGT

**Dear customer.**

The Danish government has decided to close our borders from today the 14th of March at 12.00 noon, and until the 13th of April.

The closing of border does not include transport of goods, but it will obviously be more difficult to pass the borders. We expect that our drivers will meet limited accessibility on their way to work, and all this will result in a negative effect on our lead times and capacity.

The capacity on ferry lines to and from our neighbor countries are at this very moment also being reduced, which will have an impact on our work.

In other European countries different actions are being taken in order to limit the spread of coronavirus. This will also have a potential negative effect on our transport services.

At LGT we are monitoring the situation closely. In this very moment we are planning normal departure on all routes to and from Denmark. We keep until further all lines open.

We follow any guidelines from the Danish authorities, and the management at LGT are several times per day meeting in our task force to secure the correct and necessary decisions to be taken. If a reduction in capacity and routes will be relevant to conducts, we will secure full information to all customers.
